- In the event of cancellation, £10 of the entry will be retained to defray costs.
- Entry Fee Refunds may only be granted up until the closing date. After this date
 a refund will be made on receipt of a doctor or vet certificate if a place can be
 filled from the wait list.

- Objections must be made within 30 minutes of the offence and must be accompanied by £25, which will be refunded if the objection is sustained.
- No horse/pony may compete more than once
- Horse/Pony may not have gained any BE points at novice or above
- No stallions are permitted on the showground during this event
- Competitors must present themselves to the steward for tack inspection at least 20 minutes before their dressage time.
- Competitors eliminated during the Show Jumping phase may only go Cross Country with the permission of the Official Steward
- INSURANCE Anyone competing MUST have his or her own insurance at a minimum of third party cover.
- Dogs MUST be kept on a lead at all times
