

COMPETITION RULES

1. The competition will be run in accordance with BE rules.
2. Appropriate dress must be worn, hard hats must comply with current BE standard, rule 7.2. Hats must be worn at ALL times when mounted. Plaiting is not required.
3. The Judges' decision is final.
4. The organisers and landowners accept no responsibility for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, ponies, riders, grooms, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
5. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry, cancel a class, withhold a prize or disqualify a competitor for any reason they deem necessary.
6. In the event of cancellation, a £5 administration fee will be retained to defray costs.
7. No refunds will be given after close of entry. A 50% refund will be made if more than 7 days' notice of withdrawal is given.
8. No misuse of the whip, equipment or practice fences will be allowed.
9. Objections must be made within 15 minutes of the offence and must be accompanied by £15, which will be refunded if the objection is sustained.
10. Horses/Ponies must not be left tied to lorries/trailers and left unattended.
11. Horses must be 4 years old and over.
12. No lungeing.
13. Dogs are welcome but must be kept on leads at all times and cleared up after.
14. All children must be supervised by an adult at all times.

Dressage will be held on grass and show jumping in Rectory Farm's 80m x 50m fibre-sand arena.

Dressage warm up will also be on grass and the SJ warm up in the 20m x 60m arena
