

Terms and Conditions of Hire of Rectory Farm Arena

- If cancellation is made within 48 hours of the booked time payment for the booking will still be required.
- All PC/RC/Clinic bookings (for 2 hours or more) must pay at least a £20ph deposit up front; this is refundable up to 7 days prior to the booked time.
- All droppings **MUST** be picked up from the arena and the car park area after use, and disposed of in the buckets provided.
- All jumps **MUST** be returned to approximately 90cm – 1m, ensuring no poles are left on the ground. If you change the stride distances between fences please return after use.
- Rectory Farm reserves the right, in exceptional circumstances, to cancel the booking without notice.
- Hirers must stick to their allocated time slot so that they do not interfere with any other bookings. Set up time should be included in the booking.
- Under no circumstances must the cross country fences be jumped.
- Use of the arena is at the hirer's own risk. All hirers are advised to check the arena before entering to ensure that it has been left in a safe condition by the previous occupant.
- Neither Rectory Farm nor any of its employees shall in any way be liable for any accident, injury, damage or loss.
- It is mandatory for all riders to wear a protective helmet to British Standard EN1384, ASTMF 1163, or PAS 015 AT ALL TIMES while mounted on Rectory Farm property. Body protectors are recommended but are not mandatory.
- Children under 16 must be supervised at all times.
- All damages/breakages must be reported and either replaced or paid for.
