Rules of Entry

Rules and Conditions of Entry Your entry is deemed to include acceptance of these rules

- 1. The competition will be run in accordance with the relevant Pony Club Sport Rules 2020
- 2. Each District Commissioner is required to certify the eligibility of each horse and rider
- 3. The Judge's decision is final.
- 4. Protests and Objections please see Rule 43 in Pony Club Show Jumping Rule book 2020
- 5. Horses/ponies competing may only be ridden by their competitor.
- 6. No horse or pony may be ridden more than once in each class.
- 7. No horse/pony under the age of 5 may compete in the Show Jumping.

Entries

- 1. Telephone entries or entries without the appropriate fee will not be accepted.
- 2. In the event of cancellation, £5 of the entry fee will be retained to defray costs. Please send a SAE in the event of cancellation for the remaining entry fee to be returned.
- 3. After the relevant closing date no substitution may be made of horses or riders except in the case of illness, lameness or other unavoidable circumstances which must be certified in writing by the relevant District Commissioner to the secretary. No substitutions can be made after the competition has started.
- 4. A booking fee of £1-£1.50 will be added to each entry, per person/per class.

Event Liability

- 1. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these
- bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

Mini Maior

The Olympia London International Horse Show has once again invited eight lucky Members of The Pony Club to take part in the Mini Major Show Jumping class at the show which is held at Christmas time. Each Pony Club Member will be paired with one of the senior International riders competing at the show and the competition is a pair relay with the time of the Pony Club Member deciding the winner. This is a once in a lifetime opportunity for 128cm pony riders to compete at a FEI 5 star International show.

Rules

Open to members of The Pony Club aged 12 and under, riding ponies 128cm and under.

Mini-Major warm-up class. Single-Phase, Speed 325 mpm, Maximum height 90cm.

Followed by:

Mini-Major qualifying class. Table A7, Speed 325 mpm, Maximum height 90cm.

The winner of the class will be invited to compete at Olympia subject to eligibility. In the event that the winner has already qualified, qualification will pass down the line.

Eligibility

Any rider who has taken part in The Pony Club Mini-Major at Olympia in previous years is not eligible.

In order to be selected for the Mini Major, the rider must have paid their Pony Club Membership fee in full and must have attended at least 3 Branch/Centre or Area rallies between 1st July 2019 and the date of the qualifying competition. (Team training does not count as a rally, see the Pony Club Handbook for further information).

An application form will be sent by The Pony Club to each rider provisionally selected for Olympia. Before selection can be confirmed, this form must be completed and returned by a parent or guardian and signed by the DC of the Member's branch.


