Arena 2: NSEA Grass Roots Qualifiers

- Class 1 40cm Cross-Pole Clear Round (may be led/assisted)
- Entry Fee: £13 per combination

Class 2 40cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may be led/assisted)

Judged on style only. There will be an additional prize for the best horsemanship displayed by a rider under 6yrs on 1st Jan 2022.

Entry Fee: £20 per combination

Class 3 50cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may be assisted)

Single Phase. There will be an additional prize for the best horsemanship displayed by a rider under 7yrs on 1st Jan 2022.

Entry Fee: £20 per combination

Class 4 60cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (un-assisted)

- Single Phase. There will be an additional prize for the best horsemanship displayed by a rider under 8yrs on 1st Jan 2022.
- Entry Fee: £20 per combination

Class 5 70cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may not be assisted)

Single Phase.There will be an additional prize for the best horsemanship displayed by any rider.Entry Fee:£20 per combination

Main Arena: NSEA RPL Team & Individual Qualifiers (30cm rule applies)

Class 6 70-75 cm RPL Teams & Individuals

Single Phase. Open to all Entry Fee: £20 per combination

Class 7 80-85cm RPL Teams & Individuals

Single Phase. Entry Fee: £20 per combination

Class 8 90-95cm RPL Teams & Individuals

Single Phase.

Entry Fee: £20 per combination

Entry Fees: £20 per combination per round. To include paramedic first aid cover, NSEA levy and VAT A one off booking fee of £1.50 will be charged per rider at the time of booking.





NSEA Rules – For the comprehensive Grass Roots Rules go to NSEA General Rules 2021-22 on the NSEA website. See below for eligibility in the height classes:

Grass Roots Rules for classes 2 - 5

GR1) Classes & Eligibility

40cm Grass Roots classes are judged on rider position and style only over a simple course of fences. Riders may be led or assisted. Classes may be split into a) led and b) assisted. This class is for genuine novice riders only. ANY RIDER who has competed in ANY 70cm class (or higher) on ANY pony at ANY competition (not just NSEA) is NOT eligible for this class, (except h/c if space permits)

50cm Grass Roots classes will be a single-phase competition. May be assisted but not led. This class is for genuine novice riders only. ANY RIDER who has competed in ANY 80cm class (or higher) on ANY pony in ANY competition (not just NSEA) is immediately ineligible for Grass Roots 40 & 50 cm qualifiers & championship classes. Also, ANY PONY / RIDER <u>COMBINATION</u> who have competed at 70cm in ANY competition (not just NSEA) are NOT eligible for this class, (except h/c if space permits)


60cm Grass Roots classes will be single phase competitions, no outside assistance. Horse/ Rider <u>combinations</u> who have **completed** courses at 80cm (at ANY competition, not just NSEA competitions) may only compete h/c in 60cm classes, or they must ride a different pony.

70cm Grass Roots classes. Single phase, no outside assistance Riders jumping at this level are not eligible for 40cm Grass Roots on ANY pony.

The purpose of the Grass Roots programme is to provide very novice riders with the opportunity to experience the excitement of competition. The rules are, therefore, kept as flexible as possible but, please embrace the "spirit" of the rules. Please do not use Grass Roots competitions as an easy opportunity to "pot hunt," as it is not in the spirit of the competition.

The top 6 teams & individuals at qualifiers will be eligible to compete at any Regional Grass Roots Championships.

Rosettes will be awarded to the top 4 teams & the top 8 individuals in both the Grass Roots and RPL classes

Outside assistance will not be tolerated- and could result in elimination. NSEA affiliated competitors only may warm up & compete horses on the show ground

All competitions, parents and representatives from every school must ensure that they act courteously to stewards and officials at all times. Most of them are volunteers and rudeness is not acceptable.

Withdrawals made prior to the closing date will be refunded less a £5 administration fee. Withdrawals made after this date will only be refunded upon receipt of a doctor's note or veterinary certificate.

In the event of cancellation, your entry will be refunded less a £5 admin fee.

In the event of oversubscription, a ballot will be drawn on Tuesday 21st June in accordance with NSEA rule AR1
